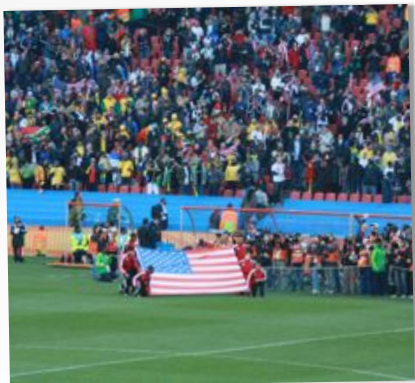

Busy World Cup Month

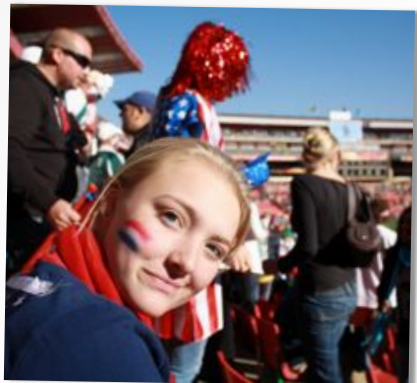
